2021 BURGUNDY

Crisp, fresh whites - Elegant, fruity reds

2021 saw a return to traditional, classic Burgundy with the cooler summer giving wines with fresher flavours and lower alcohol. After three vintages of dense, concentrated wines, the 2021s are hugely attractive, fruity wines that will drink beautifully at an early age.

The growing season got off to a precocious start with temperatures in March as high as 25C. Bud burst was early and many vines were already in leaf when night time temperatures plunged to as low as -10C on the first weekend of April. Frost damage was widespread with the earlier-budding chardonnay on higher slopes the worst affected. This included much of Chablis and the premiers crus of Meursault, Puligny and Chassagne. In these areas the yields were as low as 10 hl/ha (20% of a normal crop) and given the small size of many parcels, some wines have simply not been produced.


A cool summer with regular rainfall required continual vigilance against oidium and mildew but the severely reduced crop allowed the fruit to ripen more easily and the best wines were made with little or no chaptalisation. Vinification was less easy than in 2020. The fruit required careful sorting to eliminate unripe or rotten berries. The whites benefitted from a more severe debourbage than normal and most red wine producers opted to destem the majority or all of the bunches. Macerations were gentle with less pumping over and punching down of the cap.

A year ago, in my 2020 vintage report, I wrote that given the small 2021 crop 'my advice is to buy sooner rather than later'. I would say the same today. Volumes are down significantly and world-wide demand is at an all-time high so many wines will sell out quickly.

To compensate for the shortages, I have been on buying trips to Burgundy twelve times since the April 2021 frosts and we have been fortunate to add a number of new estates to our portfolio; Ch. de Laborde, Frédéric Magnien, Duc de Magenta, Philippe Bouzereau, Guy Bocard, Laurent & Romain Pillot, Yvon & Laurent Vocoret, Laurent & Céline Notton and Céline & Frédéric Gueguen.

Please note that the prices in this offer correspond to the size of the cases in which the wines will be shipped.

We will be holding our tasting at The Caledonian Club on Tuesday, 10th January 2023 at which many of the growers will be present to show their wines in person. I hope to see you there.

Samuel Billaud

Samuel is making many of the most exciting wines coming out of Chablis today, equal in quality to those of Jean-Marie and Bernard Raveneau but at a fraction of the price.

In 2021 Samuel harvested towards the end of September, the small crop as a result of the April frost reaching good levels of ripeness despite the cool growing season. The wines are beautifully fresh and crisp with lower alcohol and higher acidity than in 2019 or 2020 and mark a return to classic, flinty Chablis. As usual, the wines are aged on the fine lees for between nine and eighteen months depending on their development before being bottled with only the lightest of finings and filtration.

Domaine Roy

The Roy family have been vigneron in the village of Fontenay, just to the north of Chablis, for over 200 years. Today Claude Roy, together with his children David and Karine, farm 18 hectares of vines on the right bank of the River Serein, where they are one of the largest owners of the grands crus including a magnificent 3.5 hectare plot in Bougros.

All the wines are vinified in stainless steel vats and aged on the fine lees for 9-12 months before bottling. This is an exemplary range of classic Chablis displaying precise, fresh, vibrant fruit on the nose together with ripe, generous textures on the palate.

Claude and Karine lit hundreds of candles on three successive nights in April 2021 and managed to mitigate the effects of the devastating frosts. The result is a lovely, elegant wine, full of fresh fruit, crisp acidity and a long, generous aftertaste. Drink 2023-2027.

Domaine Laurent & Céline Notton

Laurent and Céline Notton established their 16 hectare estate in 2005. Initially, they sold all their production in bulk to the Beaune negociants but, in recent years, they have increasingly turned to bottling the wine themselves. The estate is centred on the village of Chichée which lies on the banks of the River Serein 3 km upstream from the town of Chablis.

Laurent believes in waiting for the grapes to attain full ripeness before harvesting and the majority of the wines including their splendid premier cru Vaucoupin are vinified in stainless steel vats to preserve the maximum of fruit and vitality.



Jean-François Bordet

Domaine Séguinot-Bordet

Jean-François Bordet runs this splendid, hugely successful, family estate that can trace its roots in the village of Maligny back to 1590. The domaine now extends to over 20 hectares on the right bank of the River Serein where the high proportion of kimmeridgian limestone gives the wines additional minerality and intensity.

All the wines with the exception of the grands crus are vinified in stainless steel vats in order to preserve the maximum of fruit and freshness.



Domaine Yvon & Laurent Vocoret



This 26 hectare family estate, based in the village of Maligny, dates back to 1707 and is currently run by the 6th generation, Laurent and his wife Clémentine. It was Laurent's father, Yvon, who was the first in the family to bottle his own wine rather than to sell it all in bulk to the Beaune negociants. A new cellar has been built above the village of Maligny to accommodate the increasing production and, judging by the quality of recent vintages, the future is bright.

Stephanie & Vincent Michelet

Domaine Courtault-Michelet

Stephanie Courtault has taken over the running from her father, Jean-Claude Courtault, of his domaine and merged it with the estate she has built up with her husband Vincent Michelet. The cellar and the majority of the 29 hectares of vines that they now farm are situated in the village of Lignorelles, 10km to the north-west of the town of Chablis, but they also own vineyards throughout the appellation including important holdings in Beines and Villy. Most of the wines are vinified exclusively in stainless steel vats with the exception of the old vine cuvée, La Croix Saint Augustin.

Domaine Gueguen

Céline and Frédéric Gueguen both come from local Chablis families. Céline is the daughter of Jean-Marc Brocard and worked with her father before setting up her own estate with her husband Frédéric Gueguen in 2013. He had previously worked both with Jean-Marc Brocard and Jean Durup, two of the largest estates in Chablis.

Céline and Frédéric now have 36 hectares of vines in and around Chablis which are currently being converted to organic viticulture and a winery in the village of La Chapelle Vaupelteigne.

Domaine Saumaize-Michelin

Roger and Christine Saumaize are handing over the running of the estate to their children Vivien and Lisa.

All 14 hectares of the estate are farmed biodynamically and the 2021 harvest was late, from 23rd to 29th September, in order for the grapes to achieve full maturity. At 24 hl/ha, the overall yield was the lowest of Roger's career (as well as frost, there was hail in Fuissé and Solutré) and, as a result of the small crop, all the wines were fermented in barrel.

This brilliant young wine-maker has made a name for himself in both his home region of the Jura and in the Mâconnais where he has expanded his holdings considerably by buying the famous Jean Rijckaert estate from the eponymous Belgian restaurateur. He now vinifies an exemplary range of Mâconnais wine in his cellar in Davayé in the heart of the Saint Veran appellation.

All the wines are barrel-fermented in 10-25% new oak barrels and aged for 12-15 months on the fine lees before bottling.



Jean-Marc and his son, Antonin, are now right at the top of the list of Chassagne estates producing both pinot noirs and chardonnays of the very highest order. In 2021, the harvest ran from 17th to 24th September with yields as low as 9 hl/ha in the premiers crus as a result of the April frost. Vinification is at low temperature with fermentation in 228 litre barrels from a range of *tonnelleries* including Billon, François Frères, Chassin and Tonnellerie de Mercurey. After 12 months in oak, the white wines are racked to spend a second winter in stainless steel vats before all the wines are bottled in the spring.

Jacques will not be releasing his prices and allocations until he has bottled the wine around Easter 2023.



These larger vessels enable his wines to retain the maximum of freshness and vitality, a hallmark of the domaine.

He subsequently sold the château building on to become a luxury spa hotel whilst retaining the adjacent cellars and the vineyards that he had planted in the château's grounds.

In 2021, the brothers harvested the small crop promptly and quickly with the majority of the white wine grapes being harvested on just three days between 18th and 20th September.

Jean-Baptiste Bouzereau, a second cousin of Charles and Philippe, harvested more than four weeks later in 2021 than in 2020, from 19th to 25th September. As a result of the low yields and meticulous tending of the vines, all the fruit was ripe (12.5 to 13% potential alcohol) and very little chaptalisation (to 13%) was required.

Vinification was, as usual, principally in 228 litre *pièces* with most wines racked into stainless steel vats after 12 months ageing on the fine lees. Bottling will be at the beginning of 2023. This is a splendid range of wines combining richness of flavour with fine vitality and minerality.

Domaine de La Pousse d'Or

Benoît Landanger has taken over the running of this fine, biodynamic estate from his father Patrick. In 2021 the harvest ran from 23rd to 29th September. The whole crop was destemmed and a strict sorting was necessary. The volume was down 60% compared to 2020 as a result of the April frost. Domaine Bertrand Ambroise

Bertrand and Martine Ambroise have handed over much of the day to day running of the estate to their children, François and Ludivine. François is now vinifying the wines with less extraction so that whilst the wines retain the big, bold flavours for which the estate is well known they also show greater charm and finesse.

In 2021, the red wines averaged a satisfactory 35 hl/ha across the domaine with good yields in the Côte de Nuits but a pitiful volume in the Côte de Beaune where the frost devastated the more precocious sites. The whites were also severely affected with less than 20hl/ha produced overall. Quality, however, is high with a natural concentration due to the low yields compensating for a cool growing season. Most of the fruit reached a highly satisfactory 12.5% potential alcohol and were vinified without the need for any chaptalisation giving fresh, elegant, harmonious wines. All the reds were destemmed except for the two Vieilles Vignes cuvées where half the bunches were fermented whole.

Domaine Jacques Cacheux et Fils

Patrice and his son Charles continue to harvest relatively late at full maturity, destem all the grapes and practise a careful extraction of tannin with the minimum of *pigeage*. All the barrels come from *tonnellerie* François Frères in Saint Romain and the style remains one of rich, ripe fruit allied to just the right amount of new oak.

The yields in 2021 were the lowest that Patrice has ever seen and he didn't have sufficient volume to vinify his individual plots of Vosne-Romanée separately. However, the wines have a natural concentration as a result and the domaine remains a fine source of top quality Vosne.

Domaine Michel Magnien

Frédéric Magnien is the fifth generation to run the family estate. Since he took over in 1996, he has expanded the domaine from 4 to 18 hectares with the whole estate being farmed biodynamically since 2010. Frédéric continues to develop the range of vessels that he uses for ageing the wines and this year has added new 225 litre clay jars to his existing stock of 228 litre oak barrels, smaller 160 litre clay jars and larger 350 litre terracotta amphorae made by TAVA in Italy. His aim is to have approximately half of each wine aged in barrel and half in the more neutral clay vessels.



As well as running the family estate (Domaine Michel Magnien, see page 48), Frédéric buys grapes from many of the best growers in Morey and the surrounding villages which he vinifies in a separate cellar adjacent to the domaine. The majority of the farmers who supply grapes work organically or biodynamically but not all, so most of these wines are not labelled as such. The vinification is carried out with the same methods (partial destemming and ageing in both oak barrels and terracotta amphorae) and with the same care and attention as the domaine's wines and the results are equally impressive.

Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini

Florence and Simon Heresztyn-Mazzini run one of the most improved domaines of Gevrey-Chambertin. Farmed biodynamically, they have produced an amazing run of vintages since they took over their share of the Heresztyn estate in 2012.

In 2021 they made a modest 28 hl/ha, slightly more than in 2020 (27 hl/ha) but well below the ten year average. The harvest started on 19th September and took the usual 7 days with the need for careful sorting of the grapes to eliminate any unripe or rotten berries. A higher proportion of the bunches were destemmed than in previous vintages and fermentation was at a lower temperature in order to maximise the fruit and avoid the extraction of too much tannin. The result is a beautiful range of vividly fruity, harmonious wines that perfectly reflect the terroir of each individual vineyard.

Château de Laborde

Hervé Kerlann bought the Château de Laborde in 1998 and has since renovated the château and re-invigorated the estate. In 2016 he built a new winery and today the domaine comprises 9 hectares of vineyards, principally in Gevrey-Chambertin.

In 2021 all the fruit was systematically sorted, destemmed and then fermented at a relatively cool temperature in order to extract only the finest tannins. Domaine Rossignol-Trapet

Brothers, Nicolas and David Rossignol, were one of the first to convert their vineyards to biodynamic viticulture as early as 2004. The 13 hectare estate is widely recognised as one of the finest in the Côte de Nuits and is blessed with a glittering array of Gevrey-Chambertin premiers and grands crus.

The 2021 harvest ran from 26th September to 2nd October. The grapes achieved a good level of ripeness (12-13% potential alcohol) and required only a light chaptalisation. 65% of the bunches were destemmed, more than usual, and maceration involved more frequent remontages and one or two pigeages, a practice that had been abandoned in 2019 and 2020.
